## Qualifications for Apprenticeship

An individual who can show that they meet the conditions listed below will be afforded an oral interview by the JATC. If interviewed, the applicant will be added to the JATC Eligibility Pool, a ranking of applicants qualified for selection, for a period of two calendar years from the date of interview.

### TO BE INTERVIEWED, THE APPLICANT MUST:

- A. Complete an application form, accurately responding to all questions and items.
- B. Be a minimum of 17 years of age. Prior to being indentured, applicants selected from the Eligibility Pool must be at least 18 years of age.
- C. Be at least a high school graduate or have a GED Certificate.
- D. Show evidence of successful completion of: one full credit of basic high school algebra with a passing grade of C or higher; or one post high school algebra course (ie: Continuing Education, College Course, Trade School Course, etc.); or provide evidence of having successfully completed the Online Tech Math Course through our national training center.
- E. Provide an official transcript for high school (required) and for any post high school education and training you would like included in your file (optional). If you have a GED Certificate, you must provide an official score report from the Department of Education. All transcripts and certificates must be in the original sealed envelopes.
- F. Submit a DD-214 to verify military training and/or experience if you are a veteran and wish to receive consideration for such training and/or experience.
- G. Take the Electrical Trade's Aptitude Test at the JATC and pass with a score of 4 or higher.
- H. Present a valid photo ID or birth certificate. Prior to being indentured, applicants selected from the Eligibility Pool must present evidence that they possess a valid driver's license as well.
- I. Pass a physical and drug test. Prior to being indentured, all applicants given a conditional offer of employment as an apprentice are required to take a physical and drug test.

Individuals who meet one of the following qualifications do not have to fulfill the requirements of items C and D listed above, and still must take the Aptitude Test listed in item G, but do not have a minimum score requirement:

1. Individuals who can provide indisputable documenting evidence to verify that they have worked a minimum of 2000 hours in the electrical construction trade, under a journeyman or master electrician.
2. Individuals who can provide indisputable documenting evidence to verify that they have a minimum of two years of military training and experience in a Military Occupational Specialty (MOS) applicable to the electrical construction trade (as determined by the JATC).
